LOS ANGELES BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL WILL MONITOR LAPD INVESTIGATIONS OF COMPLAINTS REGARDING RECENT PROTESTS

Los Angeles - The protests, marches and demonstrations over the past week have generated many videos, comments and posts on social media alleging excessive force by Los Angeles Police Officers. Any individual who would like to make a complaint can be assured that their allegations will be thoroughly investigated.

The Office of the Inspector General, which reports to the Board of Police Commissioners, has been reviewing these social media posts and videos to ensure that those appearing to depict an excessive use of force result in an investigation by the Department, whether or not a public complaint has been filed.

Their office will also monitor the Department's investigations into complaints made by members of the public to ensure that they are completed thoroughly, accurately, and in an unbiased manner.
